

This is an opportunity for us as third years to take over the Lowry, show our work to the public, and take on either admin, production, marketing or finance roles.


There will be a series of performances, with solo and group pieces of all different styles.



Come along to our endof year exhibition, showcasing the best of the MUA and SFX BA student's work!





# Neurodiversity in Education

Recently Nathaniel Dickson our Disability Officer gave an interactive talk on 'Empowering Neurodiverse Learners', discussing strategies for supporting students within higher education.

He delved into the unique and often invisible challenges faced by neurodiverse students and offered practical advice for our staff to continue on creating a sympathetic, inclusive and supportive learning environement here at UCEN.

Nathaniel emphasised the importance of clear instructions, one-to-one engagment and personalised learning plans (PLPs).



Nathaniel is continuously striving to make sure students individual needs are listened to and catured towards.

#### You can find him to talk about:

- Creating or reviewing your PLPs, which do the following:
  - Explain your conditions and needs to tutors and allied staff
  - Accessing the DSA that you are entitled to
  - Gathering and summarising relevant evidence of your 'disability'
  - Exploring the implications of your 'disability' and options for support
  - Enhancing your independence and confidence in voicing your needs
- Seeking a diagnosis
- Finding a support group near where you live or study
- Preparing for a meeting with curriculum or management
- Coping and adjusting to a new diagnosis or a diagnosis you did not expect
- Communicating with staff
- Joining UCEN's student ran Neurodiversity Society
- Advice about assistive technology:
  - Using generative Al
  - Mindmaps and how they can help in planning assignments
  - Read Aloud and Dictate
  - Immersive Reader

# Ciz Hatton

"I'm Caitlin Woodend, a student at the Manchester Film School and the Core Representative for Creative Arts and Media Industries.

You may have seen images or articles about Liz, a 17-year-old girl who had the privilege of meeting the Princess of Wales. Liz wasn't just an extraordinary young woman - she was my cousin.

Liz was diagnosed with a rare and aggressive cancer called **Desmoplastic Small Round Cell Tumour (DSRCT).**Tragically, she passed away just 10 months after her diagnosis. DSRCT affects children and young adults, and with only a 15% survival rate over five years, there is an urgent need for better treatments and support.

To honour Liz's memory, my family has founded **The Desmoplastic Small Round Cell Tumour Charity.** 



#### Our mission is to:

- · Fund research for more effective treatments.
- · Provide support to DSRCT patients and their families.
- · Compile and share critical resources for those affected by this rare cancer.

We are the only charity in the world dedicated solely to DSRCT, and we're determined to change the future for families facing this devastating diagnosis.
