






Student Adventures!

The Theatre & Performance 3rd years took their performances far beyond the walls of UCEN last term in two expeditions that celebrated international collaboration and cultural exchange! They enjoyed workshops, immersed themselves in the local cultures and put on some amazing performances!



The first group went to Laşi, Romania and worked with a variety of groups, including MA English & American Studies students and students from two international high schools.

They designed and facilitated workshops focused on playfulness and building confidence, and attended a choreography session at the National University of Arts George Enescu to observe students in action!

They also got to perform their show 'Echoes and Here and Now' in an arts cafe called Negru Zi. The show explored the

colour green; looking at themes of nature, hope and how there can be light amongst darkness.

Their host Lotus Havârneanu helped organise all these remarkable experiences and collaborations. Sounds like this was an unforgetable trip!

The second group went to Porto, Portugal and got to experience the beautiful culture, taste the delicious food and see the sites!

They had the opportunity to participate in an improvisation night with other students at Esmae Drama School, and watched a dress rehearsal performance by their 2nd years. They also got involved in facilitating workshops at the drama school, masterclasses and presentations.

They also got the opportunity to share their work with other students by performing their piece which explored different types of conversations and interactions people could and should be having.

Sounds like such an amazing time, connecting with others and exploring the beauty of new ways of working and seeing such a rich culture!


Squareball Society
