# Library Lowdown

Our libraries stock the books and resources you'll need to help you through your studies with a range of flexible opening times.

They hold an expansive range of more than 100,000 physical titles across all of our subject areas and also have a large collection of online resources, including professional and academic journals, as well as specialist subject materials.

All their resources are easily found using the **Discover tool,** which offers a quick way to search for the item needed.

As well as reading materials, our libraries also offer access to an archive of more than 2 million TV and radio broadcasts.

You can access our online resources 24-hours-a-day and our dedicated library staff are available to assist you with any enquiries during the day. We also offer introductory workshop sessions to help you find your way around and another session focused specifically on the subject you're studying.


